## Services

### Metro

The easiest way to reach Bombay Exhibition Center, especially during the peak traffic and rush hours, is to take the Mumbai Metro Line 7 (Red Line) to and from Goregaon East Metro Station. The metro station is just outside the Bombay Exhibition Centre, with about 100 meters walk. This is the most convenient option, requiring no transfers or additional transport. This Metro line from Dahisar to Gundavali (Andheri East) allows you to connect with further transport options.

### Parking

Separate areas have been designated for Visitor's car parking within Bombay Exhibition Center. Entries to these areas is from Gate 1 of the venue. This facility is directly managed by Nesco. Goods vehicles are not allowed to be parked in the Visitor Parking Area.

### Left Luggage

For the convenience of visitors and exhibitors, HGH India has created Left luggage facilities near the Visitor Registration in the halls. Visitors and exhibitors can avail of these facilities free of cost during the trade show days from 09:00 a.m. to 06:30 p.m.

### Free Shuttle Bus Service

For the convenience of Exhibitors and Visitors, HGH India has arranged free shuttle bus services between the trade show venue and important entry and exit points in Mumbai city as well as railway stations close to the venue. These include domestic airport, international airport and key railway stations namely Borivali (East), Goregaon (East), Ram Mandir (East), Andheri (East) and Western Express Highway Metro Station.

### Taxi

The Mumbai metropolitan region offers a range of metered and radio taxi (Call-a-Taxi) services. The concept of online booking of taxis is convenient and popular in Mumbai. Radio taxis can be hired at Domestic and International airports and Central railway stations where outstation trains terminate. You can download Ola and Uber apps for easy booking.

### Restaurants/Cafeterias

During the set-up period, a functional cafeteria will operate at different points in the venue. Every hall will have a functional food and beverages service for the construction teams on payment basis. This entire food service will be managed by Nesco Foods and no food purchased from outside the venue premises will be allowed at the venue as per rules.

During the trade show days from July 01-04, 2025, food courts, restaurants and cafeterias at multiple locations inside the halls as well as elsewhere in the premises will be functional. Exclusive lounges set up by the organisers will also offer hospitality to the eligible exhibitors and visitors.

Free drinking water is provided by the organisers during the set-up days as well as trade show

days to all exhibitors and visitors. Also, it can be bought from cafeteria and restaurants within Bombay Exhibition Center.

### Lounges

As always, HGH India has created unique facilities for its visitors and exhibitors in terms of Fruit Lounge, Popcorn Lounge (Hall 6), Foot Spa (Hall 3) and Hot Lounge (Hall 4). All these lounges are open for service to all eligible visitors and exhibitors for the duration of the entire show during business hours, to enable them take a quick break and get back to business.

In addition, all the halls will have visitor lounges serving as Meeting Point and Resting Point for the visitors.

### Prayer Room

Prayer room has been created within the premises of the halls for those wishing to offer prayers during the trade show hours. Exact location can be found by following signage or from information desks located in the halls.

### Media Lounge

Media Lounge is located in Hall 3 with all facilities like Internet, working desks and refreshments for bonafide and registered media persons.

### Medical Services (First Aid)
